Create a photo album that will inform your reader about your topic. You will create 8 illustrations that show important information about your topic with captions. You will also include one diagram and one chart.




There should be <u>no blank space</u> in your pictures. The pictures should be filled with color and details from the book.

## Example of a diagram:





## Example of a chart:


